# Empirical Research to Examine the Effectiveness of Supporting Policies to SMEs of Handicraft Industries in Lao PDR as to Realize Some Collaborations with Traditional Craft Industries in Japan

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### **Preface**

Since fiscal year (FY) of 2001, the Japan External Trade Organization (JETRO) has supported handicraft industries in Lao PDR in cooperation with the Lao Handicraft Association (LHA) on the basis of a request from the government of Lao PDR. Through these projects, companies of handicraft industries in Lao PDR have enhanced not only the techniques how to manufacture with good designs, but also the ways of marketing how to sell to whom. As results, some handicraft companies in Lao PDR have realized collaboration with traditional *Kimono* producers in Kyoto by supplying fabrics.

This research project entitled "Empirical research to examine the effectiveness of supporting policies for SMEs of handicraft industries in Lao PDR to realize some collaborations with traditional craft industries in Japan," organized by ERIA Support Office, JETRO and Institute of Developing Economies, JETRO (IDE-JETRO) in FY 2018, is a first trial to empirically evaluate the effects of such support projects. The support projects evaluated in this research project are GIFT project, conducted in FY 2015 – 2017, and SOZAI (materials) project, an ongoing project, which has just started in FY 2018. Both projects were implemented by Business Development and Human Resources Support Department, JETRO and JETRO Vientiane. For evaluating the GIFT project, IDE-JETRO and Economic Research Institute for Industry and Trade, Lao PDR (ERIIT) conducted a questionnaire survey with samples of 184 handicraft companies in Lao PDR. For SOZAI project, we set targets to realize collaborations between handicraft companies in Lao PDR and companies of traditional craft industries in Japan and we closely observe how an interior and lifestyle producer, Mr. Junya Kitagawara, lead the companies in Lao PDR to realize the target. Consequently, ten handicraft companies in Lao PDR exhibited their works at SOZAI exhibition at the 5th Life × Design exhibition at the Tokyo International gift Show Spring 2019 in February 2019 and 46 business talks were held between the handicraft companies in Lao PDR and visitors to the exhibition.

This research project, however, could not have been realized without supports from various persons and organizations.
